PUBLIC ASSISTANCE REGARDING EVADING VEHICLE ACCIDENT

On March 30, 2012, at about 11:00 p.m., Meriden police officers were dispatched to the area of Hanover Ave. and South Second St. for the report of a pedestrian that had been struck by a motor vehicle.

Upon arrival, officers found a 17-year-old girl lying near the sidewalk. She was complaining of severe head pain, but was able to convey some information to responding officers.

The female said she was crossing Hanover St. (from south to north) when she was struck by a car that was traveling west on Hanover St. The car then fled the scene.

Two individuals witnessed the accident and said that the vehicle is described as a small two-door red vehicle. It is believed to have damage to its front end. The windshield may also be damaged.

The pedestrian was transported to St. Mary's Hospital where her condition is unknown at this time.
