**Incident: Double Stabbing**

**On September 21, 2012 at approximately 9:31 P. M. the Meriden Police Department received a 911 call from an anonymous female who reported that there were two male victims that had been stabbed on Kensington Avenue. Both victims were reported to be on Kensington Avenue in the area alongside the property of the Midstate Medical Center. Since there was a Meriden Police Officer on scene inside of the hospital, he and multiple members of the Midstate Medical staff responded out to Kensington Avenue.**

**Once outside on Kensington Avenue, two male victims were located in close proximity to one another and each one had been stabbed. Both males were transported into the hospital to be treated for their wounds. Both of the male victims were teenagers and at this time one of them has died as a result of the stabbing. The second teenager has since been transported via LifeStar to the Hartford Hospital to be treated for his injuries. At the time of this release the status of his medical condition is unknown.**

**At this time the identity of the suspect(s) responsible for the stabbings is unknown and the investigation is ongoing. The names of the victims are not being released at this time as they are both juveniles and the appropriate notifications to their families are being cared for.**

**This investigation has just begun and at the time of this release there are no other details that can be made available. The Meriden Police Department is asking anyone who may have any information regarding this incident to contact Detective Martin Eisner at (203) 630-6260.**
